## Financial Report by Celeste Lilley

### Water Reclamation Facility

- We are continuing to work out the fine details of the agreement with Fire Mountain Farms on the removal of biosolids from the old facultative lagoon. It's looking like we will be able to reduce the cost for this portion of the planned WRF improvements.
- The slab for the new reclaimed water filter is scheduled to be poured this week.
- SWD personnel are still battling with the inflow meter chart recorder at the plant.
- The Raptor is back on line suffering no major damage from the frost.

### Meter Setters

- Scott will be installing setters in Divisions 7, 11, 17, and assorted missed residences.

### Water Consumption Metering Results

- Readings from our water meters on occupied single family residential lots in SunLand for the last 30 days averaged **150** gallons per day. The average

daily consumption, based on an annual average per connection, is **196** gallons.

- The SG&CC facility has averaged **457** gallons per day over the last 30 days, compared to a historical average daily consumption of **1014** gallons.

## **Other**

- Water production, expected to be down compared to last year, was in fact down in 2013. In 2012 we pumped 87,432,000 gallons and in 2013 we pumped 80,568,000 gallons.
- SWD will be scheduling visits this spring with water meter and metering technology vendors.
- Discovered there are twenty-five group A water systems in Clallam County serving less than a thousand connections. This information can be found under the WS DOH Main Page under “Access Sentry Internet.”
