Requirements and Specifications for New Water Connections

Revised July 14, 2014

- 1. Any new water service connection to the SunLand Water System must include a meter and setter appropriately sized for the service use. Typically this will be a 5/8 by ¾ Sensus iPERL touch read in gallons to include the water box lid adapter.
- 2. Any new water connection in Southern View Estates or with an underground irrigation system must include a Washington State approved Backflow Prevention Assembly installed at the customer(s) side of the meter setter. Whereas a new connection is a potential cross-connection, a cross-connection permit must be on file with the water district. There is a \$25.00 fee for a cross-connection permit.
