Water Reclamation Facility

- Willy is continuing to work with Al Friedli at Evolution Controls to develop a scada system and replace the paper chart recorders at the WRF.
- We have replaced the old microscope at the WRF. The new one will have a camera attachment and will be connected to a computer so we can share/send photos of what we're viewing.
- Willy and Rich are continuing remodeling and re-organizing at the WRF lab.
- The crew at the WRF is evaluating options for replacing the air blowers for the SBR's. These blowers provide the extra air needed by the bugs consuming the waste.
- And the WRF team is replacing other lab equipment that has passed their end of useful life.

Water Meters/Meter Setters

• Scott has completed the March water meter readings. The next water meter read is planned for the first week in May.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The water level in both wells is normal.
- Total water production numbers continue to baffle us, as they continue to be much higher than expected. Dutch and Jay have tested the meter on well no. 1 and it appears accurate. The meter on well no. 2 is a turbine and it can only slow down, giving us low production numbers, not high. At this point we are looking at a significant leak or water theft.

Other

- The battery bank for the emergency generator at the lower reservoir has been replaced and is functioning properly.
- Repurposing Judy's old computer to the WRF.
- CA Homes is building on a lot behind the upper reservoir/well.
- Mike will be attending a Small Water Systems work group at the Clallam County Courthouse in April.
- Placed logs at Taylor Lift Station as temporary barriers
