Water Reclamation Facility

- Covid testing of the wastewater has been discontinued at least for now.
- The WRF crew and other SWD team members have been fine tuning the new wheel line irrigation system.
- The quarterly monitoring well report has been completed and submitted.
- The farmer has harvested 125 tons of silage from the spray field this cutting.
- Rich has hauled 62 dry tons of sludge to Sequim over the last month. That product was 2.82% solids. 3% solids are the thickest we can pump into the truck. We can expect to be hauling a bit more for a time.
- Rich has his Wastewater Collection System Operator Certification.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The next total water meter reads will be the first week in July.
- The water level in both wells is falling slightly as we move further into the irrigation season.
- Total water production numbers continue to appear high. We are continuing to look for leaks or other reasons for high production.

Other

- David Ketsi of Evergreen Rural Water of Washington is here this week to continue leak detection work. The plan is to go across Emerald, East on Medsker and also on Hogans Vista.
- SWD personnel will be replacing a failed water service line under Lesli Lane near the tennis courts this week.
- All District fire extinguishers have been checked and serviced.
- The Golf Club will be removing a tree from the 11th fairway whose roots plugged the sewer mainline.
- 2011 Ford Ranger going to dealer for recall work.
- SWD personnel are preparing to install a concrete pad for the new emergency generator to be placed at the main sewer lift station.

- Scott, Rocky and Sam repaired the long-standing water leak at Taylor Blvd. and Sunland Drive.
- SWD personnel are working with a SLOA representative regarding herbicide use in the RV parking lot.
- SWD had Cooper Fuel top off the fuel in all emergency generators as well as our back-up supply.
- SWD approved a new sewer connection at Discovery Court.
- The water mainline flushing has been completed for the year.
