Water Reclamation Facility

- The Reclaimed Water Use Permit Application was submitted to Department of Ecology.
- Biosolids hauling: 21,000 @2.99% solids for the month.
- On Thursday, September 9th, Brian was notified an SWD employee had come in contact with a positive COVID-19 person. Brian requested the person stay home, get tested, and not come to work until the test result was back. Fortunately, the individual tested negative and returned to work on Monday, September 13th.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- Meters were read the first week of September. The next total water meter read will be the first week of October.
- The water level in both wells is staying about as last month as we continue through the warm and still irrigation season.
- Total water production numbers continue to appear high. We are continuing to look for leaks or other reasons for high production.

Other

- Schooling for SWD personnel has been completed. Everyone is now up to date on their CEU'S for the year.
- Sam and Rocky will be taking the WDM2 and WDM1 exam in October or early November.
- SWD personnel completed the storage building at the upper reservoir \$13,000 under budget.
- SWD personnel were dispatched to a home on Sunrise View on August 20th to check a report of a blockage in the sewer line. The call was in response to an email received from the homeowner requesting reimbursement for work performed by an outside company on August 12th. Tree roots were removed in a sewer line believed to be within the SWD's responsibility. Brian called Olympic Sewer and Drain to run a camera down the cleanout next to the house. The camera located a second cleanout located on the owner's property before the SWD main sewer line. SWD removed the blockage from the line and will not be paying the homeowner's claim for reimbursement.
- SWD personnel are working with JT from Straits Electric to prepare for the PUD when they are ready to proceed on the main lift station.
