Water Reclamation Facility

- Rich and Rocky are working with Scott on putting in a new test site in the system part of the new coliform plan.
- Biosolids hauling for the month is 7000 lbs. @3.18% solids.
- Willy and Rich moved the fence for the road project at Woodcock and Sequim Dungeness Way. Judy has billed Mark Sundt for materials.
- The yearly crop report was completed.
- Winterizing equipment at the plant.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The next total water meter read will be the first week of December.
- The water level in both wells is much better with the lower production.
- Total water production numbers continue to appear a lot lower. We are continuing to look for leaks.

Other

- SWD staff is working on putting in new butterfly valves in the reservoirs.
- Sam and Rocky will be taking a Cross Connection Class at the end of the month and will be taking the CCS State Certification test the beginning of December.

- SWD called Bob Eichhorn, SLOA'S greenbelt person, about a leak at the tennis court and it was quickly repaired.
- SWD and PUD, with Strait Electric, finished moving all the boxes at the main lift station. The new generator should ship November 10-12.
- The first number for the Highway Lift Station #4 is about \$100,000.00.
- Joe Backman from Smith & Loveless will be here next week with Ed Mola for a site visit at Highway Lift Station #4.
