Manager's Report by Brian Scott

Water Reclamation Facility

- Rich and Willy drained the spray field irrigation due to freezing temperatures.
- Biosolids hauling for the month were low due to the cold weather.
- Rich and Willy worked with Strait Electric and Evolution Controls on the SCADA System.
- The SWD staff worked the storm due to power outages. Last month and this month the plant alarmed out.
- End-of-year testing and year-end reports were completed and sent in to the State.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The next total water meter read will be the first week of February.
- The water level in both wells is much better with the low production.
- Total water production numbers continue to appear low. We are continuing to look for leaks. During the snow, a team was sent out to check for wet spots in the snow indicating the presence of a leak.
- SWD staff worked 12 hours the day after Christmas due to power outages.
- On Jan. 4th SWD staff had Olympic Sewer come out to scope the line at 173-177 Horizon View Drive to see if the driveway drain on gutters were connected to the sewer line. 177 is connected and 173 is not. We are

working with the County to come up with a plan. The homeowner was present and willing to work with us on this problem.

- SWD staff removed the tree at the Fawnwood Lift Station that SLOA had cut down.
- SWD, with Straits Electric and Groves, delivered the new generator at the Main Lift Station. Now waiting for Cummings to come out on January 11th to do a start up with SWD staff.
- There was a power outage at 2:30 a.m. on January 6th and SWD staff worked at the Fawnwood Lift Station. PUD only had 2 power legs for the 3phase electrics needed to run the pumps.
- Manager Brian Scott talked with Utilities Service Company to see what is the next step to get the HWY Lift Station ordered.
- On January 13th, SWD staff will work with David Kenski from Evergeen Rural Water to detect leaks at no cost to the District except employee time.
