Water Reclamation Facility

- The staff at the WRF greased the aerators and mixers.
- Rocky and Rich repaired and replaced a broken yard hydrant.
- 14 loads of sludge were taken to the City of Sequim plant, total of 8400 gallons, of which 2.77% were solids.
- The Biosolids Report was submitted to DOE.
- Willy got bids to replace the Blowers at the WRF.
- Inflow and Infiltration was reported to the DOE.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The next water meter read will be the first week of April.
- The water level in both wells at lower 79 ft. upper at 14 ft. Water loss for the month of March was 16%
- Total water production numbers continue to appear low. We are continuing to look for leaks.
- SWD staff repaired a water leak at 168 Fairway Dr.
- SWD staff met with the Clallam County Road Department on a plan to better drain Taylor east of Fairway Drive.
- SWD staff worked with Steve from Olympic Sewer and Drain to locate the sewer stub at 125 Sunrise View Ave.

- SWD staff is cleaning out the barn. The old office is gone.
- The SWD Manager is working on a quote to get a sewer to lot 14 (locate at first lot on the left on Taylor Blvd. across from Sunland Drive). Water is on location.
