Water Reclamation Facility

- Willy and Rich completed well testing for the quarterly tests.
- Lab test and monthly reports were submitted to the DOE.
- 17 loads of sludge transported to Sequim plant (14,200 gallons 2.80 % solids).
- Installed new pressure switch for reclaimed water wash-down pump.
- Field harvest produced 137 tons of silage.
- Bi-yearly maintenance has begun.
- WRP received an award from the DOE for outstanding performance in 2021.
- Brian passed the Wastewater Test and is now a certified WW Operator 1.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The next water meter read will be the first week July.
- The water level in both wells: Lower well 76 ft. Upper well at 15 ft. Water loss for the Month of May was 21%
- Total water production numbers are starting to move up. We are continuing to look for leaks.

Other

- SWD staff worked on cleaning and mowing upper and lower reservoirs. Reports are all good.
- SWD staff are staying busy with lawn building maintenance.
- Joe Besson has been here a month and working out great.
- SWD staff is working on the barn between other projects.
- SWD staff is prepping for the new Highway Lift Station.
