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Water Reclamation Facility

- Staff are winterizing equipment at the WRF.
- The WRF has received both the dissolved oxygen meter and the new flow meter for effluent flow.
- Ten loads of sludge were taken to Sequim plant: 14,000 gallons @ 2.85% solids.
- Willy met with Straits Electric to talk about upcoming blower project at the WRF.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The next water meter read will be the first week December.
- The water level in both wells is lower: Upper Well 77 ft. and Lower Well at 17 ft.
- Total water production numbers are down from last month. We are continuing to look for leaks and bad meters. October water loss was 16 %.
- SWD staff repaired a leak on Southwestern Place.
- Rocky took monthly samples to the County lab this week.
- During normal morning rounds after the windstorm, it was discovered that a large tree had fallen on the upper reservoir building. As SWD staff did not feel comfortable removing it, Blue Mountain Tree Service was called to take the tree off the roof.

- Due to roof damage caused by the tree falling on the upper reservoir building, SWD asked McCreary and Son Roofing for a repair estimate. At the present time, the roof is not leaking or contaminating the water source.
- SWD staff spent a day cleaning up after the windstorm.
- The HWY lift Station should arrive the second week in December.
- The Lower Reservoir is still awaiting delivery of the new generator. Straits
 Electric reports the generator is on backorder from the factory and has not
 been built yet.
- Steve from Olympic Sewer and Drain was up at Kelsey Court running the camera down sewer stabs to find the connection point.
- Work on the new office room and barn is coming along very well.
