Manager's Report by Brian Scott

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Water Reclamation Facility

- Nine (9) loads of sludge were delivered to Sequim plant - 12,600 gallons @ 2.34% solids – 2465 dry pounds.
- A new flow meter was installed and is working well.
- An influent electric valve failed. New parts were installed and adjusted (caused several late-night alarm calls).
- Biannual servicing of equipment at the WRF is being done.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The next water meter read will be the first week in March.
- The water levels in both wells show little change - upper well at 77.5 ft., lower well at 17 ft.
- Total water production numbers are down from last month. Water loss is 10% for January. We are continuing to look for leaks and bad meters.
- SWD staff and the crew from Smith & Lovelace installed the new HWY Lift Station. It is in operation and running well.
- Rocky took monthly samples to the county lab this week.
- The Taylor Lift Station bypass pump went out. A new one is on order at a cost of approximately \$6,500.00.
- SWD staff noticed the owner of 185 Sunset Place has moved her fence back close to the property line of the SWD's Upper Reservoir.
- The SWD has installed a new fence around the generator at the Upper Reservoir.
- Ford Maverick will provide the VIN number of the new truck we ordered in the 14th week which is around the 1st of April.
