Manager's Report by Brian Scott

Water Reclamation Facility

- Ten (10) loads of sludge (bio-solids) were delivered to Sequim plant @ 2.69% solids.
- Wire needed for the control box to the blower is on back order.
- Planning and framing the pad for the new blower is in process.
- Straits Electric was contacted about wiring the new blower to the building.
- Reports were submitted to the Department of Ecology.
- WRF staff performed Infiltration and Inflow Evaluation
- The waste load assessment was completed.
- Chart recorders were removed from the TP control center.
- Work is commencing on DO meters and blowers.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The next water meter read will be the first week in April.
- The water levels in both wells show some change upper well at 78.5 ft., lower well at 18 ft – up just about a foot.
- Total water production numbers are down from last month. Water loss is 10% for February. We are continuing to look for leaks and bad meters.
- SWD staff put down gravel at the Highway Lift Station.
- Rocky took monthly samples to the county lab last week.
- The new bypass pump installed at the Taylor Lift Station is working well.
- The culvert on the east drive of the District Office was clogged. SWD staff dug it up and cleaned it out.

- SWD staff completed maintenance and grounds clean-up at all lift stations.
- Maintenance is being performed on all mowers and equipment before mowing season.
- SWD staff are exercising systems valves.
- The District Manager located a "Small Water System Management Program Guide".
