Manager's Report by Brian Scott

Water Reclamation Facility

- Rich hauled 10 loads of sludge to Sequim- 14,000 gallons @2.63%.
- The new blower is in place and running. SCADA was updated as well.
- Monthly reports were submitted to the State Department of Ecology.
- The lab is still not completing tests on time. The District requested a letter from the lab to be cleared from being out of compliance.
- The irrigation field harvest was 110 tons.
- Accumulated brush was burned before the burn ban went into effect.

Water Production/Consumption Results

- The next water meter read will be the first week in July.
- The water levels in both wells are up a little from last month – the upper well up 1.8 ft. and lower well up 1.5 feet.
- Total water production numbers are down a little from last month. Water loss is 11% for May. We are continuing to look for leaks and bad meters and non-metered water.
- The District Manager continues to work on an updated Small Water System Management Plan.
- Rocky took monthly samples to the county lab last week and all passed.
- SWD staff is preparing for the Sanitary Survey scheduled for July 21st.
- SWD staff cleaned up the building previously used for the old generator.
- SWD staff cleaned and painted the floors at the upper and lower reservoirs.
- SWD staff completed monthly lift station maintenance.
- Staff attended a PUD class on “Call Before You Dig” on Thursday, May 25th.

- The District Manager signed papers at Price Ford to enable anyone from the District to pick up the new Maverick truck when it is delivered.
- SWD staff is painting street valves.
- SWD staff completed hydrant flushing.
- SWD staff are trimming back bushes around the test station and fire hydrants.
- The District Manager sent in CCR and WUE Reports to the State that are due on July 1, 2023.
- The District Manager set up an outside contractor to conduct leak detection in SunLand July 24th through July 26th.
