Water Reclamation Facility

- The WRF passed all performance evaluation tests including, coliform, turbidity, BOD, dissolved oxygen, pH, residue solids. 5/21/24. Thanks to Rich, Willy, and Pat for operating the plant at such a high level.
- Met with Hi-Tech Security to go over price quotes for cameras and control room security system. 6/3/24 Total project cost \$ 4,262.55 Will install as soon as all components arrive.
- Johnson Electric plans to install new Fawnwood Lift Station electrical control panel this Thursday 6/20/24.
- The possibility of installing a controller to make the WRF front gate open electronically is being considered.
- Denny from Secord Excavation declined to provide a formal bid to prepare the site for the new building. Willy will request a bid from other contractors.

Water

- 5/22/24 Potholing fire hydrant on Sunland Drive, and Sunset Place. Hydrant replaced by C&J Excavating on 6/14/24.
- Completed the lead/galvanized service line identification program & sent to DOH 6/3/24.
- Met with lan Jones from Jamestown water/sewer on development plans across Woodcock on 6/12/24.
- Once weekly turbidity and pH sample tests from each reservoir starting 7/1/24 8/1/24
- We have an interlocal agreement with the City of Sequim for processing biosolids. John Christianson (Utilities Manger). The City may be able to provide support for SWD future projects.
- Looking at the pros and cons of procuring a portable vacuum excavator vs. the mini
 excavator we now have which could be sold to partially offset the cost of the vacuum
 excavator that would be used to a greater extent than the mini unit.
- Water loss for the month of May was 2%, down from 7%.
